

ZONE R.A.M Signal Sheets,
 “V” - Require Assistance;
 “X” - Require Assistance, **Medical**

ZONE TAGS show the path taken.

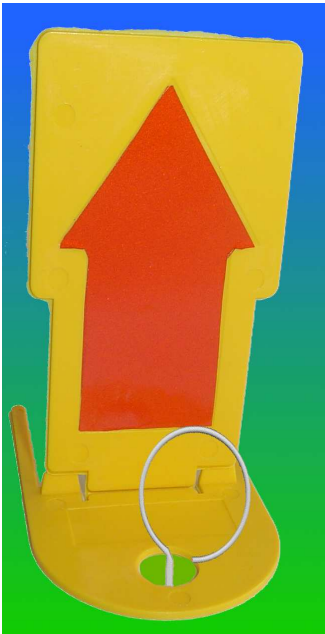
The Leader of a group has the responsibility to **lay** one TAG every 200 steps/metres/yards, or at an intersection, showing direction taken.

When the **Leader** runs out of TAGs they wait after 1 kilometre/ 1000 yards for the **Tail** person to arrive, exchange TAGs and begin again.

The **Tail** person has the responsibility to **collect** all 5 TAGs and exchange them with the **Leader**.

Following this **Method**, the group will keep in close quarters and always be within 1 kilometre, The **Leader** can backtrack to the previous TAGs if the group stops for any reason.

ANCHORING TAGS AGAINST WIND



←.....→ 5cm
←.....→ 7cm
Recycle a wire coat hanger
and make 5 holding pegs.

A supply of 5 Pegs and 5 Ties can be carried on the Leader's Lanyard.

Alternatively on the ground use :

- Tent Pegs
- Rocks
- Dirt
- Snow
- Undergrowth or small Dead Twig.

Use "Elastic Tie with Clip", from electrical hardware, or reusable "Plant Ties", from gardening store, to secure tags to trees etc.
